



Detailed Member Registration Instructions

Updated: September 1, 2017

Instructions If after reading *and following* these instructions you are still having problems contact the Region Office at 515-727-1860 from 8:30am-4:30pm Monday through Friday or email <u>carol@iavbreg.org</u>.

- All registrations MUST be completed and ACTIVATED before you can participate in ANY activities including practices and tryouts. Be aware that with electronic acceptance it is important that adult members register themselves and that a parent/guardian registers a junior player.
- To complete the online registration with online signature you will need to have the last 4 digits of your Social Security # or your driver's license number on hand. Junior age players will need to have a parent/guardian complete the process; and the parent/guardian will need the last 4 digits of their SS# or their driver's license number. (If you do not have a parent/guardian available for the online process you will need to do a paper membership form. The Junior player and parent will both have to sign the form (3 signatures each) and send it to the Iowa Region Office or give to their Club director.)
- Membership fees may be paid online with a MasterCard or Visa. You will need a card with a 3 digit security code on the back. If you do not pay online (select Submit Payment separately), send your money along with the member name and date of birth to the Region Office or give fees to your Club Dir/Team Rep to send in as a group. Fees must be received and processed by Region staff prior to ANY participation.
- If you are a <u>new lowa Region member, but have been registered with another USAV region in the last eleven seasons</u> please contact the Region Office before registering. **Your region affiliation must be changed PRIOR to registration.**
- If you were registered in Iowa last season; but want to join another region please contact our Region Office or the Region you have moved to before registering. Your region affiliation must be changed PRIOR to registration.
- Begin registration by clicking on one of the Login buttons Renew Membership (previous) or New Membership.
- If you are a returning member, but do not know your login you can use the Forgot Password link. You will need to have
 the email address that is currently in your online record and your date of birth if you don't remember your user name. If
 you no longer can access the email that is current in your record you will need to contact the Region Office to get your
 login.

Junior Players

Your parent/guardian will need to complete the online membership process for you. They will need their driver's license to complete the process. For those that don't know what club they will be participating with they should choose UNDECIDED (top choice) for your club. Once your club is decided you can login, expand the Member Area, click on Member Profile, click on the club name in the drop down menu (don't scroll) and finally click on the Edit Contact Info button at the bottom of the screen. If you picked a specific club (*on purpose or accidentally*) and you are not playing for that club, you must contact the Region Office to have your club affiliation changed. (In some cases the club director may need to be contacted to confirm you are not a member of their club.)

Junior Age Assistant Coach with a Junior Club

- You register as a full junior member even if not playing. A junior age assistant coach must be 2 years older than the team you are coaching. You must always have a registered and USAV background screened adult head coach at least 21 years of age present at all practices and during team travel and events.
- Those junior age coaches **that** are already 18 years old will have to complete the registration process, logout and login again to complete their background screening and electronically sign their Junior Club Personnel Code of Ethics. (Once the code of ethics is signed please contact Carol, <u>carol@iavbreg.org</u> so you can be marked eligible as an asst. coach.) Those that turn 18 during the season will need to login to your membership on your birth date and click on the Submit Background Screen under Member Area to complete the screening.

 Junior age coaches (17 and under) will need to complete a <u>hard copy</u> of the Junior Club Personnel Code of Ethics signed by them as well as their parent/guardian (not available electronically). Completed forms can be faxed to 515-727-1861, scanned and emailed to carol@iavbreg.org or mailed to Iowa Region Volleyball, 8170 Hickman Rd Suite 5, Clive IA 50325-4400.

Adults affiliated with a Junior Club or working Junior Events Requirements

- Must sign a USA Volleyball Junior Club Personnel Code of Ethics form each season prior to participation. This requirement is for all adults (18 years or older) <u>actively participating</u>. The acceptance is initiated when indicate a junior club role or working junior event on the 2nd screen of the registration.
- Need to complete the USAV background screening prior to participation. Screenings are good for two seasons once cleared.

SafeSport certification and IMPACT certification needs to be completed before contact with juniors; and **is REQUIRED before being placed on a roster**. (Junior age assistant coaches must complete both as well.)

- SafeSport certification New 2017/18: three 30-minute courses completed on the USAV Academy beginning Oct 2nd.
- **IMPACT coaching** certification (USAV coaching course) if not already completed by **all head and assistant coaches**. Region event only coaches must complete IMPACT Part A in year 1 and Part B by year two. Qualifier, Nationals or out of region event coaches must complete both IMPACT Part A and Part B in their first year.

Online Registration Overview:

- On the 1st screen you will be entering information or verifying your personal information. The personal information is the applicants' (not their parent/guardian). Please use <u>Legal</u> names. (Do not use Beth or Liz for Elizabeth or Bob instead of Robert. You can enter Beth, etc. in the Preferred Name box.) Returning members with a name change (first or last) need to have Region staff change their name online (<u>do not</u> create a new membership).
- Use capitalization as required in the First Name box title case has been removed to allow for names like LaTisha.
- Junior members must select a grade. Adult players select level of play. Non playing adults may leave the level as UA not applicable.
- New in 2015/16 members now create their login before continuing to the 2nd screen of the registration. You will enter a
 User Name, Password, confirm password, pick a security question and answer the question.

- **Stop** when registering a junior member and you get adult membership types on the 2nd screen. You need to click on the Edit button in the upper left to go back to the 1st screen. Verify that the birth year is correct and/or the grade level hasn't changed to HS Grad, correct the error that has happened and hit Continue again.
- A club must be selected on the 2nd screen (near the top on right). If not known at the time of registration choose Undecided (top of list) as the club affiliation. <u>Click on the club name – don't scroll</u>.
- Adults that are working with a junior club as well as playing need to register with the junior club. Region staff will put them on their adult roster.
- Adults need to select all roles that apply. There isn't a referee or scorer role under the junior roles so you just indicate that you will be officiating at junior events listed under Unaffiliated Individual Roles and Interests to initiate the background screening process.
 - Unaffiliated Individual Roles and Interests:
 - I am an unaffiliated Adult.
 - \square I am interested in officiating at Adult Tournaments, (either as a scorer or referee).
 - I am interested in officiating at Junior's Tournaments, (either as a scorer or referee).
 - (By electing to officiate in a Junior Program, you will be required to submit a background screening authorization.)
- Adults that decide to work with a junior program after completing their registration or forgot to mark junior club role will have to login again and complete the Junior Club Personnel Code of Ethics by clicking on the link and the Submit Background Screen tab, if not current. Coaches need to contact Carol at <u>carol@iavbreg.org</u> to manually mark them eligible as a coach if they complete their code of ethics after registering.

- If a role was selected that requires a background screening the adult applicant will be directed to the screening section (if needed for this season) after submitting the 2nd screen. If the screening is current, the system will advance to the confirmation page.
- Background Screening Procedure: Enter SS # (if not already entered), read, check the box to electronically authorize the screening and click Continue and Process Background. NOTE: SS #s are needed for the screening company to complete the screen, but the # isn't saved in your personal information.
- Junior, adult and collegiate players only will go directly to the confirmation screen.
- Confirm all information is correct. If not use the Edit button in the upper left to go back and correct your record.
- The USA Volleyball Magazine is not an automatic part of your membership. You can purchase the magazine for \$2.50 near the top on the last screen of registration.

The Print Member Card tab only has the card for you to print and carry to show as proof of registration (login and click on the plus sign under Member Area on the left). You can print a new card anytime during the season as needed – after a club is chosen, after referee and/or scorer status changes, after attending Impact class, after completing SafeSport certification, etc. The card will not print for paid one day members, single event members, until the day they are registered to participate. Their membership is "Pending". They will have to carry a copy of their confirmation to show proof of paid registration. To get a copy of the confirmation login expand the Member Area and clinic on Print Member Confirmation. Only the first page is needed.
