Junior Team Officiating Requirements

Adult Officiating Requirements.

- 1. You must have at least 1 registered adult that has completed the referee requirements to be a 1st referee for playoffs.
- 2. Teams 14u & younger must have a registered adult that has completed the scorer requirements fulfilling one of the scorer positions at the table (no longer required of 15u teams).
 - a. 16-18 year old junior members may assume the 'adult' scoring position with 10-14u teams once scorer certified.

Junior Officiating.

- 1. The kids will need to complete the junior referee or scorer courses to be referees or scorers.
- 2. Teams must have R1, R2, Scorer, Libero Tracker and 2 Line judges.
- 3. Junior Players may be R1 during pool play, but the adult must be either the second referee or stand by the R1. They must help the R1 by whistling missed calls.
- 4. During Playoffs (bracket play) and Adult must be the R1.

Adult Officials Registration & Certifications

- 1. If coaches, they must meet coaching requirements and take Club Ref and Scoring courses.
- 2. If Non-Coach Parent or Adult official
 - a. Be a USAV Member use the \$30 membership
 - b. Complete a background screening every 2 years- \$18
 - c. Do the Junior Club Personnel Code of Ethics Agreement- found during registration process.
 - d. Complete SafeSport training- free
 - e. Complete Club referee and scoring clinics for area they are helping with.
